ACADEMIC BOOK PRICES INTRODUCTION

A. W. WAMSTEKER-MEIJER

The Seminar on Library Management, organized by LIBER, and held in the Staatsbibliothek Preussischer Kulturbesitz in Berlin, 24th – 26th September 1975, resulted in the formulation of a number of recommendations. Thus the Seminar stated that: it is necessary to make a further study and establishes to that end a committee consisting of Mr. E. Mittler, Mr. J. L. Schofield and Mrs. A. W. Wamsteker in order to examine which areas of library management research need closer study and which areas of library management research have a high priority, and to submit their findings to the executive Board of LIBER for their consideration by the end of May 1976.¹

This committee met in Cambridge in November 1975. The three members were unanimously of the opinion that it would not be easy to get an international project really going, in spite of the signs of willingness to cooperate shown in Berlin. They therefore decided to advise LIBER to start with a small project, which would not place too great demands on the participating libraries, and would yet be useful to everybody involved. Thus the issue of academic book prices was chosen. The material for this project should not be too difficult to collect. Proceedings should then be developed for the collecting and standardization of the material from the various countries, resulting in internationally useful data.

After further consultation between the members of the Working Party, by letter, a proposal was formulated, explaining the purpose of the project and recommending a realization in two stages:
„A Research Proposal for Consideration by the Board of LIBER for Submission to the Council of Europe”, report prepared by J. L. Schofield, Mrs. A. W. Wamsteker-Meijer, E. Mittler.²

As demanded in the Berlin recommendation, the Proposal was offered to the Board of LIBER in May 1976.

A RESEARCH PROPOSAL FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE
BOARD OF LIBER FOR SUBMISSION TO THE COUNCIL
OF EUROPE

1. Introduction and background to the proposal

In 1973 the LIBER General Assembly discussed the question of setting up a working group on problems of library organization and management. It was decided that a working party would be set up under the chairmanship of Dr. Drozd of the Staatbibliothek Preussischer Kulturbesitz, Berlin, to study the problems of organization and management. It was suggested the working party should be formed from the following: Mr. de Groot, Mr. Birkelund, Mr. Caipern, Mr. Carpreaux, Dr. Drozd, Mr. Häkli, Miss Lounassalo, Mr. Munthe, Mr. Schofield and Mr. Totti. All interested members of this group were asked by Mr. de Groot to attend a meeting at Braunschweig during the Bibliothekartag in 1974, which was attended by Messrs. de Groot, Drozd, Häkli and Schofield. This core group proposed a meeting of about thirty chief librarians in 1975 to study management problems.

The meeting was to consist of a general introduction to management by Mr. Schofield and reports on financial management, personnel management, and on the use of planning studies. The conference was to be partly financed by the Council of Europe in that those presenting papers would have their expenses paid, the national representatives however should obtain finance from their own resources.

Representatives from various countries attended the conference in Berlin in September 1975. Papers were presented and, as a result of these and subsequent discussions, a number of decisions were recorded, especially for European and Scandinavian co-operation if possible through the auspices of LIBER and the use of

the *LIBER Bulletin*. The expressed need for greater co-operation between countries was a continuing theme and one which received unanimous approval. Also the suggestions for conducting some form of inter-European co-operative library research would be of value not only to European librarians but to those of other countries. It was stressed that if this research was carried out in the same way in each country, using similar methodologies, then inter-national comparisons would be not only possible but most advantageous to all libraries.

One of the decisions at the conference held in Berlin was that a small working party of three should meet at a future date to consider the decisions of the conference in relation to the preparation of a co-operative research proposal. The research proposal, when completed by the working party, was then to be submitted to the LIBER Board and if approved by them, that they in turn submit it to the Council of Europe for their consideration with regard to its relevance, usefulness, and hopefully, to obtain some financial assistance to allow its implementation.

The three persons nominated by the conference participants to carry out a study and prepare a report are the authors of this proposal. A meeting was held at Cambridge University in November 1975 between the three members of the working party who reviewed the findings of the October conference. The working party decided that although all countries were most willing to participate in simultaneous research projects of a statistical nature, they would find the controlling, arranging, organizing and development of a methodology, suitable for application in all the countries involved to be a large undertaking, especially as this would be on a part-time basis. In view of this, and considering that it is essential that any first co-operative scheme should have every opportunity of succeeding, it was decided to select an area of library management common to all, and one in which all librarians are interested and consider both important and useful. Further the project should not be too difficult to devise or install, and should produce useful data within a short space of time. The one area which the working party agreed would be a most suitable one to start with, bearing in mind the limitations imposed, was the subject of „Academic Book Prices”.

2. Survey of book prices

It is considered that a greater knowledge of book prices and the production of a yearly index of changes would be of great use to librarians. The questions of stock purchased and the total amount published in any given year by subject, its cost, its budgeting implications, etc. are only a few of the essential ingredients implicit in the management requirement for a librarian to meet his readers' needs within his financial allocation or commitments. A great deal of thought and discussion has already been devoted to the standardisation of statistics on both national and international scales. We expect therefore to see an increasing use being made of quantitative data in libraries and suggest that the successful application of quantitative methods in other disciplines is leading towards their adoption by those organizations which fund libraries. We consider it is important that librarians must select that data which emphasises the salient point of the library situation to help him decide policy relating to the purchase of books; their price is obviously of paramount importance to any library policy.

The Cambridge University Library Management Research Unit (LMRU) have carried out a brief examination of the literature and had discussions with a number of librarians which disclosed that a great deal of interest, both in Britain and other countries, is being shown in this area, especially with regard to an index of book prices. At the IFLA Conference in 1972 William Kurth of Washington University Libraries, U.S.A., gave a paper appealing for each country to, in effect, compile a price index in respect of their country's publications.

Since early 1974 the Cambridge University LMRU have been collecting data on British book prices divided between books considered to be „academic non-fiction” and other „non-fiction” which are listed in the British National Bibliography (BNB).

This yearly analysis is being continued and published by the LMRU. The first survey of „The Average Prices of British Academic Books 1974” is attached to this proposal. It will be seen that various tables have been produced, e.g.

- a. the average prices of „academic” non-fiction books subdivided by 48 subject areas and totalled at each Dewey main classification.

- b. an analysis by type of binding of BNB 1974 „academic” non-fiction publications together with data on the average prices of hardback and paperback editions.
- c. the difference in price between hardback and paperback editions for different sizes of books.
- d. the average prices by subjects of ALL items (academic and non-academic) categorised by the BNB as Government publications.

Using 1974 as the base year the Research Unit will produce in the future an index of the changes in price of academic books. The usefulness of this statistical data to librarians has already been demonstrated to the Cambridge Research Unit by the demand for the publication.

It is with this in mind that we as the appointed working party recommend the production of similar data, for European and Scandinavian countries. This in turn may prompt other countries to follow our lead. To give some idea of the output of literature by country we have produced some date on publications (see p. 73). This date was extracted from the UNESCO Statistical Yearbook, 1973. A summary of the estimated 1972 world book production (number of titles) taken from the same source, is given below. It gives some idea of European book production in relation to the rest of the world.

3. *Proposal for future research*

It is therefore our proposal that a project to produce information in order to develop a statistical data base on book prices in respect of European countries should be undertaken. This project should be in two stages.

Stage ONE - Proposal The LIBER Board should approach the

Council of Europe, or some other body, who would be willing to finance a Workshop to discuss the following:

- a. extent and scope of the study
- b. methodology for each country
- c. date to start data collection
- d. date for publication of results
- e. an estimate of each country's financial requirements/involvement.

It is further proposed that the Working Party meet as soon as possible to arrange and organize the Workshop. This will enable them to inform all participating countries of the form the Workshop will take. It is desirable that the participants attend the Workshop in full knowledge of their national situation in respect of book prices, so that final plans can be made at the Workshop for the creation of a data base. This group will require a small amount of funding in order to meet at some convenient location. A report on these meetings would be prepared for the LIBER Board and the relevant funding body.

Stage TWO -Proposal As a result of the decision and arrangements agreed at the Workshop, the Working Party should act as a Control Group to co-ordinate the project, arrange for the analysis of the data, and the publication of results, etc. A further Workshop should be convened towards the end of the first data collection year in order to discuss the relevance of the data being produced, any proposed alteration to the data collection methods, and the continuance of the project. At this Workshop it is suggested consideration should also be given to the question of obtaining data on how much of the book production of one country is purchased by another country and the difference in the purchase price of this material.

Reports on the above will be submitted to the LIBER Board and the relevant funding body.
